Thanks. It's good to know.

Have you contacted Dr. Merritt about the diagnosis? During our clinic visit, he said he had not checked those values. We asked why, and he told us that the person doing the lab will make suggestions if the modest amounts of 3-OH dicarboxylics are significant.

Even you cannot release full raw data, could you please do me a favor by asking Dr. Merritt to check those data and then tell us the values and ranges.

Since Dr. Merritt said the "modest amounts of 3-OH dicarboxylics" is so important to eliminate FAOD diagnosis, we do need those values for his diagnosis.

I believe that BestDoctors had contacted the medical record office for records, we are working with them for 2nd opinion. It's not reasonable to hold this information from them. Another thing is that SCH medical record office failed release Jianhua's urine organic acids, blood acylcarnitine, and plasma amino acids to BestDoctors last year.

Since I copied my email to Sarah and I have not received any correction from her, I assume our original communications (email) is accurate. If it is possible, could you please talk to Dr. Merritt to discuss if it is necessary to release this critical medical information? (Double check please.)
